

Decree of the Chairman of the Egyptian Drug Authority No. (783) of the Year 2022

The Chairman of the Egyptian Drug Authority,

After reviewing:

- Law No. (127) of the year 1955 regarding the practice of the pharmacy profession;
- The Egyptian Drug Authority Law, enacted by Law No. (151) of the year 2019, and its Executive Regulations;
- Presidential Decree No. (18) of the year 2020 forming the Board of Directors of the Egyptian Drug Authority;
- Minister of Health Decree No. (709) of the year 2019 regarding the reorganization of sampling procedures for analysis at the National Organization for Drug Control and Research (NODCAR);
- The presentation made by the Head of the Central Administration for Operations;
- And in the public interest (interest of work);

Has decided

(Article One)

The provisions of this decree shall apply to the sampling and analysis of human, veterinary, and herbal medicinal products, disinfectants, cosmetics, pesticides, raw materials, medicinal plant extracts, and similar substances, in accordance with scientific references and developments.

(Article Two)

The Central Administration for Operations shall be responsible for developing a random sampling plan through the collection of random samples to monitor products during their validity (shelf-life) period.

(Article Three)

The Head of the Central Administration for Operations shall issue an organizational guide outlining the procedures for sampling and analyzing products during both the registration and post-registration phases, as well as the measures to be taken in the event of non-compliance.

(Article Four)

This decree shall enter into force from the date of its issuance, and any provisions contradicting it are hereby repealed.
