2. What you need to know before you use GlucaGen®

### **Important information**

GlucaGen® contains sodium

GlucaGen® contains less than 1 mmol sodium (23 mg) per maximum dose (2 ml), that is to say essentially 'sodium-free'.

#### How much to use

The recommended dose is:

- Adults and children above 25 kg or older than 8 years: inject all of the medicine (1 ml).
- Children younger than 8 years or children older than 8 years who weigh less than below 25 kg or younger than 8 years: inject half of the medicine (0.5½ ml).
- Children older than 8 years or children younger than 8 years who weigh more than 25 kg: inject all of the medicine (1 ml).

#### 4. Possible side effects

Not known: frequency cannot be estimated from the available data

#### **Background:**

### Therapeutic indication

GlucaGen is indicated for treatment of severe hypoglycaemic reactions, which may occur in the management of insulin treated children and adults with diabetes mellitus.

### **Diagnostic indication**

GlucaGen is indicated for motility inhibition in examinations of the gastrointestinal tract in adults.
