

Prime Minister's Decree No. (1818) of 2019

Prime Minister

- Having perused the Constitution;
- Law No. (53) of 1973 on the General State Budget;
- Law No. (127) of 1981 on Government Accounting;
- Law of the Central Auditing Organization Promulgated by Law No. (144) of 1988;
- Decree of the President of the Republic No. (48) of 1982 on the Rules and Regulations of Joint Research Projects with Foreign or International Entities;
- Prime Minister's Decree No. (869) of 2010 on the Rules and Regulations of Control on Accepting Grants, Gifts and Donations Provided by Foreign or National Entities; and
- Having considered the approval of the Council of Ministers

has decided:

(Article One)

The text of Article Two of the aforementioned Prime Minister's Decree No. (869) of 2010 shall be replaced by the following text:

«Without prejudice to the provisions of the applicable laws and resolutions with regard to determining the authorities whose approval is required to accept grants, gifts and donations, it is imperative to obtain the approval of the president of the Authority - or whoever possesses his powers – in the case of accepting a grant, a donation or a gift whose value does not exceed one million Egyptian pounds; it is imperative to obtain the approval of the competent minister - or whoever possesses his powers - when the said value exceeds one million Egyptian pounds and does not exceed ten million Egyptian pounds; and it is imperative to obtain the approval of the prime minister when the said value exceeds ten million pounds.»

(Article Two)

This DECREE shall be published in the 'Official Gazette' and shall come into force from the day following its publication therein.

Issued at the Presidency of the Council of Ministers on *Dhul Qi'dah* 26th, 1440 A.H.
